

CONTINUE YOUR STUDIES AT EFSC!

If you are a graduating high school student who participated in Dual Enrollment, Early High or earned Dual Enrollment Credits at your high school during your senior year – *these instructions are for you!*

While you may not need to reapply to EFSC, there are some requirements you need to take care of to continue at EFSC once you graduate.

- PROOF OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION** - Depending on which semester you plan to attend after high school graduation, you will need to prove you are on-track to graduate or have graduated with a high school diploma. Here's how:

Summer Term Courses - Contact your guidance counselor to obtain a Graduation Pending Notification Form.

Fall Term Courses - EFSC will accept a copy of your diploma to allow you to register for the fall term. Request your final, official high school transcript with graduation date. Following graduation, please submit a copy of your high school diploma to the myEFSC Student Document Dropbox.

- RESIDENCY** - Submit a Residency Declaration with copies of supporting documents. Visit easternflorida.edu/go/residency.
- MEET WITH YOUR ADVISOR** - You are encouraged to meet with an advisor to discuss degree requirements and placement testing options. To schedule an advising appointment, log into the myEFSC portal and click on the Navigate/Student Resources icon.
- CONFIRM YOUR MAJOR** - To see your current major, log into myEFSC, click on myGPS icon, put in you Student ID (B number). Your current Degree and Major are listed at the top of the page. If you would like to update your major, please submit a Major Change Form to the myEFSC Document Dropbox. The Major Change Form is found on the Eastern Florida College website. We encourage you to meet with an advisor before updating your major to ensure you're on the best path to graduate. As a dual enrollment student, your major may have been restricted; upon high school graduation, you are now eligible to select a different major.
- ADDRESS CHECK** - Log in to your myEFSC portal to confirm your mailing address is accurate. The Update Address link is under the Quick Links section.
- FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS**
 - Respond to any requests for additional documentation as soon as possible. Financial Aid will notify via the Message Center in myEFSC and via your Titan email if you must submit documentation after the FAFSA.
 - Apply** for Titan Scholarships by logging in to your myEFSC between March 2023 and May 2023 and clicking on the "Scholarships" icon.
 - Apply** for Florida Bright Futures Scholarships by August 31, 2023 at FloridaStudentFinancialAid.org
