



EMPLOYEE POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST GUIDANCE

Have you had a positive test for COVID-19?

YES, I TESTED POSITIVE

FOLLOW CDC GUIDELINES

1. Notify your supervisor, AVP Darla Ferguson (fergusond@easternflorida.edu), and the COVID Response Officer, Sergeant Ricky Carswell (carswellr@easternflorida.edu)
2. Self-isolate by staying at home.
3. Monitor your symptoms and seek medical care if necessary.
4. You can be around others after:
 - 10 days after symptom onset
 - AND the resolution of fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications
 - AND with the improvement of other symptoms,
 - or when cleared by the COVID Response Officer

SYMPTOMS INCLUDE:

- Fever or chills (*over 100.4 F or 38 C*) (*Without having taken any fever-reducing medications, such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen*).
- Loss of smell or taste
- Muscle or body aches
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Cough
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or loss of appetite
- Congestion and runny nose

NO, I DID NOT TEST POSITIVE

Have you been in contact with someone who has been diagnosed with or tested positive for COVID-19?

YES

Yes, close contact. (Physical contact or contact within 6 feet for a total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period, with or without a mask).

Notify your supervisor, AVP Darla Ferguson (fergusond@easternflorida.edu) and the COVID Response Officer, Sergeant Ricky Carswell (carswellr@easternflorida.edu).

Watch for symptoms AND quarantine for 14 days, or 10 days after symptom onset and the resolution of fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications and with the improvement of other symptoms, or until cleared by a medical provider or retest.

Yes, non-close contact. (outside 6 feet or within 6 feet for a total of 15 minutes or less over a 24-hour period).

Practice social distancing, good hygiene, and watch for symptoms.
