

STUDENT EXPOSURE TO COVID-19 GUIDANCE

Are you fully vaccinated?*

***Per the CDC you are fully vaccinated:**
2 weeks after your second dose in a 2-dose series, like the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines
or
2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, like Johnson & Johnson's vaccine.

Are you having symptoms?

1. Those who have been fully vaccinated do not need to quarantine.
2. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days.

1. Stay Home.
2. Contact Barbara Kennedy, the Dean of Students' Office, (kennedyb@easternflorida.edu or 321-433-5591). The office will put you in contact with the COVID 19 Officer, Sergeant Ricky Carswell.
3. Contact your instructors to let them know you are waiting to get a return to campus date.
4. The COVID 19 Officer, Sergeant Ricky Carswell, will contact you and give you a return to campus date.
5. Contact your face-to-face instructors with your return to campus date.
6. Meet at a designated location to be cleared to return.
7. Present instructors with an "Authorization to Return to Campus" form completed by security.

Exposure is close contact to another person through proximity and duration.

- Someone who was less than 6 feet away from a confirmed infected person for a total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.
- For example, 3 individual 5 minute exposures for a total of 15 minutes.
- An infected person can spread COVID starting 2 days before they show any symptoms.
