COVID-19: COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and possibly even death. While Eastern Florida State College has taken reasonable steps to minimize the risk of exposure on College property, there is always an inherent risk of contracting the disease in any place where people are present. **Students electing in-person classes and activities on College property do so at their own risk.** In addition, students must always comply with all College health and safety requirements relating to COVID-19.

Students in isolation/quarantine for any reason who are unable to come to campus during that timeframe should make arrangements with their instructor to keep up with all class work on time and not fall behind. Instructors will work with students to create a reasonable accommodation so that their studies are not negatively impacted due to isolation/quarantine.
